- Youths riding electric scooters in public spaces
- Off-road motorbikes damaging green areas
- Speeding vehicles in residential zones

Ward Update: What We're Seeing in the Community

Street Fights

We've received multiple reports of fights occurring in the street, believed to be linked to one specific property. We're working closely with the Council to minimise the impact on nearby residents and to prevent further disturbances.

Suspected Drug Activity

Concerns around suspected drug dealing remain active. We continue to gather intelligence and evidence. If you see something suspicious, please keep reporting it—your information is invaluable and can help us take action.

Ongoing Neighbour Disputes

Several long-standing disputes are currently being addressed. We're working alongside **Brighton & Hove Mediation Service**, who have an excellent track record of resolving issues—even if only one party agrees to engage. If you're struggling with a neighbour-related issue, we encourage you to consider this service.

♦ Concerns Over Electric Scooter Use

Reports have come in regarding a young child riding an electric scooter at high speed on pavements, narrowly missing pedestrians. There are also significant concerns for the child's own safety. We are actively investigating to identify the rider and will take appropriate action.

Framenter: Electric scooters are **illegal** to use on public roads and pavements unless part of a government-approved rental scheme. They are only legal on private land with the landowner's permission.

We've received reports involving:

- A stolen moped
- A smashed vehicle window
- Shoplifting involving teenage girls
- Parcel theft from a doorstep
- Dirt bikes causing damage on the golf course

We've had **3 reported burglaries** in September, which is consistent with last year's figures. ASB reports have been pretty consistent.

Please continue to stay alert and report suspicious activity when you see it.

Crime Prevention Advice

As the evenings draw in, now is the time to:

- Set timers for indoor and outdoor lights
- Check locks and alarms
- Keep valuables out of sight
- Monitor home security cameras, doorbells, and CCTV regularly
