Ward Priorities 🎯

Our focus remains on the key issues affecting our community:

- Open drug dealing
- Youth disorder — though there's been a decrease since schools returned, we're still monitoring closely
- Anti-social behaviour (ASB) in residential areas, including concerns around rough sleepers

Key Areas and Updates 📍

Oriental Place, Sillwood Street & Surrounding Areas

You may have noticed a stronger police presence here recently. This increased patrol is a direct response to your reports and concerns. We're working closely with local businesses and organisations to find effective solutions.

Norfolk Square

Reports of ASB have increased here. We'll maintain a visible police presence and are

arranging a community meeting with fellow PCSOs for feedback and solutions. Expect details around November — we'll keep you posted!

Clarence Square & Russell Square

A big thank you to the 11 residents who attended the recent community meeting with PCSO Soffe and PCSO Batchelor. Your concerns are being taken seriously and shared with partner agencies.

Following a Day of Action on 12th September, targeted policing led to two arrests related to drug dealing and ASB. Thanks to your reports, we're making real progress!

Russell House

Following your reports, we're aware of rough sleepers, littering, and stolen bikes. We're patrolling regularly and working with local councillors on further deterrent measures.

The Seafront

Concerns about drug dealing and ASB have been raised here. We're engaging with businesses and partner agencies to implement enforcement measures, including warning letters and community protection warnings. 🚓

The Lanes

Open drug dealing around Ship Street Gardens remains a priority. We patrol regularly and appreciate any CCTV footage or reports to help identify offenders.

We're also working with the council on ASB in Bartholomew Square, especially where children are present. Expect ongoing patrols and engagement. 🚔

Clifton Hill

Reports of increased drug activity near St Michael's Church and ongoing issues at Powis Square are being closely monitored.



Our recent Day of Action in August, partly in response to your reports, resulted in two arrests. We'll continue these operations and welcome any info on other areas needing attention. 🔍
