In October, we spent some time on high-visibility foot patrols in and around the area of Roundhill. More specifically Lewes Road, Ditchling Road and around London Road train station.

We have also been popping into business and speaking to them around any concerns that they have. In addition, we have been conducting more targeted patrols on Lewes Road to tackle the underage sale of vaping products to children.

I have competed some further targeted patrols and some work around traffic offences. I have issued tickets for pavement parking and spoken to road users around the red route. We have had a few further reports of anti-social behaviour from groups of youths and continue our efforts to tackle it.

There are no community meeting we are planning to attend but are more than happy to attend any that we get invited to. Please get in touch with either me or PCSO Powell and we can have something arranged.

PCSO Powell is already in contact with the Roundhill Committee, has met the members and receive regular updates from them. This is useful as we use the information to structure our foot patrols. PCSO Powell and I are keen to help address issues in the area and would still like to work collaboratively with the residents and businesses in the community.
