📈 Crime and Community Concerns

The main reports we are getting more recently relate to shoplifting. We continue to monitor and patrol these areas where concerns have been raised.

We encourage all residents to report suspicious activity, no matter how small — every report helps us build a clearer picture and direct resources effectively.

 Current Ward Priorities

Shoplifting – Appears to still be ongoing, however we are working with the Brighton Crime Reduction Partnership (BCRP) and local businesses to address this. Subjects have been identified and there are ongoing investigations in the background.

Anti-social behaviour & drug-related activity – Regular patrols continue in known hotspots. There has been an increase in drug taking activities in and around the Sainsbury's Lewes Road car park. This has been added as a priority and there will be more targeted patrols in this area.
