

Brunswick and Adelaide PCSO Monthly Update

Hello everyone! This is your current ward update for Brunswick and Adelaide, looking back at the month just gone, and offering current crime prevention advice.

Within the month of November:

- Reports of ASB decreased from 60 reports in October to 48 reports in November. A few of these relate to drug dealing and drug use.
- Burglary increased to 2 reports in November.
- There were 3 reports of criminal damage in November.

Patrols:

There were 11 foot patrols within November and 6 recorded community engagement activities.

Key Priorities:

- To see more patrols in hotspot areas such as the green spaces, Waterloo Street gardens and surrounding roads, and along the general thoroughfare of Western Road.
