Current Issues & Police Activity

Here are the key concerns and what we're doing to address them:

Vehicle Theft

There have been a few recent vehicle thefts, particularly targeting keyless entry cars. Please keep your car keys away from doors/windows and consider using a signal-blocking pouch.

№ E-Bikes & Anti-Social Behaviour

Ongoing reports of e-bikes being ridden dangerously or antisocially in the area. We're actively working to identify those responsible, checking CCTV, and increasing patrols.

Anti-Social Behaviour - Seafront & Wish Park

We've received reports of nuisance behaviour in these areas.

Patrols have been increased, especially during evenings and weekends.

Hove Skate Park

There has been a notable reduction in anti-social behaviour here thanks to increased patrols and support from local councillors.

We continue to work with partners to maintain this progress. If you see anything concerning, please report it.

Working With the Community

- I've recently met with Westbourne Ward councillors to discuss ongoing concerns and collaborate on local solutions. These meetings will continue regularly.
- You may have noticed increased patrols around BNJC (The Synagogue on New Church Road) during recent Jewish high holy days. This was a planned safety measure to support our Jewish community.
