Crime Prevention Advice

- Choose burglar-proof doors and windows
- Use secure doors and key fobs to keep property safe
- Increase CCTV in the area
- Close and lock all your doors and windows
- Double lock any doors
- Remove valuables out of sight
- Keep handbags away from the letter box or cat flap and hide all keys including car keys.
