Currently, some key concerns in the area include:

- Anti-social behaviour on Hollingbury Rise.
- Anti- social driving on Thompson Road- Crespin Way.

In response to these issues, I will be conducting more high visibility patrols around these areas and will also be issuing 'section 59s' to those who are driving anti socially.

If a driver/ vehicle has been issued two section 59s within a 12-month period, the involved vehicle will be seized. The driver will then be required to pay a fine to recover this vehicle if they choose to do this.

Ward Patrols

I have carried out numerous patrols throughout Hollingdean and Fiveways. This month, I have specifically engaged with more businesses and shops in the Hollingdean area. This was following information to suggest shoplifting is not being reported as often as it should be.

Community Meetings & Ward Days
