Crime and Community Concerns

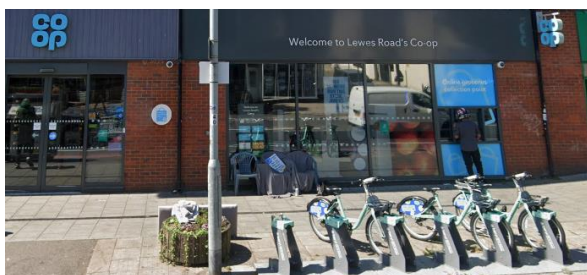
